

3 Steps


## STEP 1

Navigate to the system tray in the lower right corner of the task bar.



**STEP 2**


**Click on the greyed-out Globe icon (GlobalProtect).**



### STEP 3

**Enter in the Portal address: usmo-vpn.usmd.edu and click "Connect".**

If the portal address is already present, click "Connect".



Enter in the Portal address: `usmo-vpn.usmd.edu` and click "Connect".




## # Internet Browser

Please Note: Do not click the box to "Always allow", instead always click "Open".




## # GlobalProtect client
